

UPDATE - Notice to our Valued Residents

At Timbercreek Communities we are committed to working together collaboratively with our team and community members to create better living experiences, and as the coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19) spreads across the world, and our country, we take our responsibility as your housing provider very seriously.

During these uncertain times, the health and safety of our Residents and Team Members is our primary concern and we are doing everything possible to minimize the risks. We remain in close contact with Canadian Federation of Apartment Associations (CFAA) along with closely following the recommendations of local health officials and government leaders as they work to contain the virus.
